#### Kathleen's Corner:

'Anyone who describes asylum-seekers – regardless of how they got here – as "illegals" is guilty of perpetuating a big lie', writes \*Hugh Mackay. .... we all know what's happening. This is Australian government policy, out in the open, supported and sustained on both sides of politics. This is a national disgrace, and we are all complicit.
