Parish of Gordon Commission Update - Sue Daly & Vin Dillon

Many thanks to everyone who has provided feedback on the Interim Report. In particular it is noted that for 2018 the Report identifies an operating loss of \$38,922. However, this included extraordinary expenditure of \$25,944 for works to prepare the presbytery for sale. It is intended that this amount will be recouped in 2019 following settlement on the presbytery. Taking this into account the operating loss for 2018 would have been \$13,978. We continue to seek feedback which can be provided via the Commission feedback boxes located at the entrance to each of the churches, via email or via post (as detailed in the Report). We will convene a Parish Meeting from 5pm Sunday 24th March at Donegan's Farm, where we will review feedback on the Interim Report and collectively discern the key recommendations for our Parish leadership structure. This meeting will be followed by a Wood Fired Pizza evening!


