Year to date:

We are now working towards a draft report which summarises the approach we have taken, presents key findings and explores the 4 potential options that have been identified: reinstating the Coordinator model, establishing a single Parish Leadership team (including designated roles), appointing a pastoral associate and establishing a shared priest model. The first three options retain a Supervising Priest role. This draft report will be distributed in early February for feedback from the parish community through the month of February. Based on the feedback received, we plan to prepare a final report for submission to Bishop Paul in March.
