Thank you to the parishioners who were able to attend the Parish Assembly last Sunday to be informed of the current state of our vibrant and active parish. Reports were presented, received and discussed with an opportunity for those present to express their ideas/thoughts/challenges in an open forum. Copies of Catherine's report will be available at the back of the Church over the next two weekends, so please take the time to collect one. Your thoughts/ideas/comments are also welcome. Discussion took place around the discernment process for our lay-led community and the appointment of a new coordinator in 2016. Names will need to be submitted prior to Christmas. When we commenced on this journey in 2012, there were a number of parishioners whose names were put forward. They indicated that it was not the right time for them at that point in their lives. Perhaps, now would be good to reflect back and reconsider - now that you can see how the model operates maybe now is the time? There is an understandable tendency for us to think "it's all going well, so I don't need to do anything" or "the coordinators seem to be managing quite well so far" The last thing we desire is to be complacent, so please give this matter some prayerful thought – we need you for the future sustainability of our parish.
