Catholic Response to Royal Commission

The Catholic Church has accepted 98% of the recommendations of the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse and has vowed that the Church's shameful history will never be repeated. Bishops and leaders of religious orders expressed their deep sorrow that vulnerable children were abused, weren't believed and weren't supported when seeking justice. They said the Royal Commission "was an important and necessary period for the Australian community" and expressed gratitude to the survivors "whose courage in coming forward and telling their stories will mean that the Church and society will be safer in the future". "Too many priests, brothers, sisters and lay people in Australia failed in their duty to protect and honour the dignity of all, including, and especially, the most vulnerable - our children and our young people ... Many bishops failed to listen, failed to believe, and failed to act. Those failures allowed some abusers to offend again and again, with tragic and sometimes fatal consequences. The bishops and leaders of religious orders pledge today: Never again. There will be no cover-up. There will be no transferring of people accused of abuse. There will be no placing the reputation of the Church above the safety of children ... Today is about telling parents and telling the community that the Church has learned, it is changing and it will continue to change. Changing the culture of our Church to be answerable and open is part of the action that needs to occur." (Details: www.catholic.org.au)
