#### Parish of Gordon: Review Commission Update

As reported last week, Vin Dillon and Sue Daly met recently with Bishop Paul, Fr Kevin Maloney and Amanda Smith to progress the approach to be used for the Commission. It is intended that the process will include a review of the past 5 years, exploration of potential options for a future governance structure and discernment of an agreed way forward for the parish. The process is expected to take approximately 6 months and will include opportunities for parish members to contribute to each of these themes. Next steps include attendance by Sue and Vin at the June Parish Pastoral Council and Finance Committee meetings. There will be a report here next week.

#### Volunteer Needed Gordon Parish Safeguarding Officer

The Parish needs a volunteer to fill the role of Safeguarding Officer. The role of the Parish Safeguarding Officer is to provide support, advice and information on all matters concerning the safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults in the parish. Training in safeguarding and child protection will be provided. The appointee will require a Working with

Children Check Card and a Police Check. The position is voluntary and is supported by the Coordinator for Professional Standards. The position does not require a person to undertake investigations. The appointment is for a period of two years. This position needs to be filled as a matter of urgency as per the Parishes under the Victorian Safeguarding legislation that came into effect at the start of 2017.
