Creating a secure retirement future for the priests of the diocese is a duty and care in which we can all participate. Fifteen retired priests are currently supported by the Ballarat Clergy Support Fund. Some live privately, some are retired in units in Ballarat or elsewhere, others live in supported

accommodation. The funding required for these commitments is ongoing. Thanks to your generosity, this collection has raised nearly \$1.8 million since its inception in 1991, including nearly \$50,000 last year. Along with the priests' own contribution of approximately \$37,000 per year, this annual collection has allowed the Fund to continue to support our sick and retired clergy. Contributions over \$2.00 are tax-deductible.
