Parish of Gordon Commission Update - Sue Daly & Vin Dillon

Initial work for the Commission involves a review of our past Coordinator structure. Parishioners are now invited to finalise responses to our first survey (yellow paper), which has been available at church entrances for the last 3 weeks, seeking your views on 'What has worked well in our parish structure over the past 5 years?' The deadline for this theme is 5th August. The second theme for this retrospective component of the Commission is 'What challenges have we encountered over the past 5 years?' Blue forms are now available for parishioners to respond to this theme. Please see the white information sheets and survey forms at the entrance to each church for more detail on how you can contribute. Future work will focus on exploration of potential options for the future governance structure of the parish and discernment of a preferred structure based on a consultation process with the parish community.

St Patrick's Presbytery Update

As reported previously the process of subdividing the land to allow the presbytery to have a separate title is dragging on with the Moorabool shire and Central Highlands Water sequentially requesting additional information. We have now received advice from CHW of their conditions to be included on the planning permit; this has been forwarded to council. In a follow up on 19th July council advised the permit should be available the following week. It is yet to be received.


