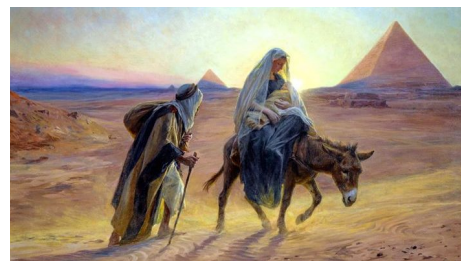


## St Vincent de Paul Lenten Appeal
