Archdeacon and companion of St. Donatus. Andrew and his sister, <u>St. Bridget</u> the Younger, were born in <u>Ireland</u> of noble parents. They were educated by St. Donatus, and when Donatus went on a pilgrimage to Italy, Andrew accompanied him. In Fiesole, through a miracle, Donatus was elected bishop. Andrew was ordained the <u>archdeacon</u> of Fiesole, serving Donatus for forty-seven years. He also founded a monastery in Mensola, Italy. Andrew died shortly after Donatus, but his sister, <u>St. Bridget</u> the Younger, was carried by an <u>angel</u> to his bedside, all the way from Ireland. Read more on www.catholic.org


