



Birth: 1233 Death: 1285

Servite <u>cardinal</u> and preacher. Born in Florence, Italy, to a noble family, he was educated in <u>Paris</u> and <u>Padua</u> where he earned a doctorate in medicine and philosophy. He practiced medicine for some time, but in 1253 he joined the Servite Order in Florence. He served as a lay brother until 1259, when his superiors directed him to be ordained. Philip soon became known as one of the foremost preachers of his era, becoming master of novices at <u>Siena</u> in 1262 and then <u>superior</u> of several friaries and <u>prior</u> general of the Servites against his own wishes. in 1267.
