

Saint of the Week: St. Dominic of Silos Feastday: December 20 Patron of captives; pregnant women; prisoners; shepherds Birth: 1000 Death: 1073
Benedictine <u>abbot</u> and defender of the faith. Born in Canas, Navarre, Spain, circa 1000, he entered the Benedictines at San Millan de la Cogolla. King Garcia III of <u>Navarre</u> challenged him when he became <u>abbot</u> of the monastery, and Dominic refused to surrender part of the Benedictine lands to the crown. For this he was exiled, going to King Ferdinand I of Castile and Leon, who made him <u>abbot</u> of <u>St. Sebastian Abbey</u> at Silos, now called St. Dominic's. Dominic reformed the abbey, built the cloisters in Romanesque style, and started a <u>scriptorium</u> that became famous throughout the region. <i>Read more on www.catholic.org/saints</i>
