### **Ballarat Case Study 28**

Since the Ballarat Hearing (Case Study 28 of the Royal Commission) concluded earlier this year, the information from the Truth Justice and Hearing Council (TJHC) has not been specific to the Diocese of Ballarat so has not been continually forwarded throughout the Diocese. The next major communication to be considered will be the Report of the Royal Commission on the Ballarat Case Study. The report is expected to be released by the Royal Commission prior to the end of 2016. We can expect this report to be confronting and distressing since it will bring together all the evidence gathered in relation to the response to abuse of Catholic organisations in our diocese.


#### "The Catholic Wrap Up"

In February the Royal Commission will hold its hearing into the Catholic Church in Australia ("the Catholic wrap up") which will extend over four weeks. Many Church Authorities have been asked to provide responses to questions that are expected to be part of the hearing which will include priesthood – initial and ongoing formation, supervision, governance – accountability and transparency. The Royal Commission has not yet called any witnesses from the Catholic Church to appear at this hearing.

We expect that the data presented as part of the "Catholic wrap up" will be shocking and disturbing for all of us.
