- I thank all who responded (approx. 280). It was pleasing to read a sensitivity to the elderly, to people who have to travel to young families
- There seemed to be a healthy tension between the Mass 'I desire' ٠ and what's best for the whole parish
- Many are happy with the present arrangements but others desire some tweaking with the Mass times
- The ministry of the clergy needs to be taken into account as well as having space for baptisms and time to travel between Masses
- Keeping our present communities together thus it is more than just ٠ attending Mass
- Important to have a weekend Mass at each church ٠
- There was an openness to lay-led Assemblies if and when required ٠
- There will be no alternating of Mass times ٠
- Weekday Masses are a different consideration depending on ٠ funerals, diocesan commitments and availability of priests
- St Pius a few would appreciate a Saturday Vigil Mass ٠
- St Joseph's a few asked for a Vigil ٠
- St Anne's Purnim asked for Mass on 1st, 3rd & 5th Sundays ٠
- OLHC majority happy with present arrangements but a few would ٠ prefer a later morning Mass. Saturday 9.30am will be discontinued. It began during Covid. A few asked for it to continue
- Koroit a few prefer Sunday Mass rather than a Vigil ٠
- Port Fairy a few would prefer a later Sunday Mass time
