SAINT JOSEPH: "CREATIVE AND COURAGEOUS BELIEVER & GUIDE"

In this year of St Joseph, Pope Francis reminds us that 'God always finds a way to fulfil his saving plan.'

God trusted Joseph to be creative and courageous to find solutions to protect Jesus and Mary. They are the very definition of vulnerable and marginalised. By protecting the Son and his Mother, Joseph was instrumental in the Paschal Mystery.
