
Third Sunday of Easter 13th & 14th April 2024

Logo: The logo for the 150th Anniversary incorporates the diocesan logo and the bough of a tree drawn by Sr Anne McMillan rsm in 1985. The words Sr Anne had used with this drawing were: "If I keep a green bough in my heart, the



singing bird will come". It is an old

Chinese proverb, which could be interpreted as a reminder to keep hope alive and a call to open our hearts to all. The bough of a tree symbolises growth, interconnectedness and life. The leaves could symbolise the communities, the parishes, the people of the diocese.
