has a personal story? The first nativity scene recorded in history was in 1223. After visiting the Holy Land and birthplace of Jesus, St. Francis of Assisi was concerned that the meaning of Christmas was being forgotten. To highlight the importance of the birth of Jesus, St Francis obtained permission from the Pope to construct a nativity scene in a cave near Greccio, Italy. It was to include the people of the town and animals, making it a living nativity scene. Although this tradition still continues today, the 19th century saw the nativity scene gradually being replaced with static displays with baby Jesus, Mary and Joseph in a manger surrounded by richly robed figurines. The Diocesan archive is organizing an exhibit of Nativity scenes from the 20th November till late January 2024 and would like to include pieces from different Parishes within the Diocese.
