Sale of St Patrick's Church Springdallah

At the public auction at Springdallah on Saturday December 8th, St Patrick's Church was sold for \$173,000. There will be a 60-day settlement. The proceeds from the sale of the Church will be deposited in the Linton Parish account held with the Catholic development fund. There are specific regulations surrounding the proceeds from the sale of Church property which restrict the use of the funds to major capital projects in the Parish. The Church pews, Stations of the Cross, Altar and Statues are not included in the sale of the Church.

It is proposed to have a **final Mass** in the Church at Springdallah that will bring this Church to a close as a place of worship. The Mass will be on **Sunday January 27th** at 10.30 am. This Mass will replace the usual 10.30 am Mass scheduled for Skipton on that Sunday.
