Child Protection Sunday – 13 September 2015

The 2015 National Association for Prevention of Child Abuse and Neglect (NAPCAN) Child Protection Week campaign continues to stress the importance of primary prevention to reduce child abuse and neglect in Australia. The theme this year is: **Be Someone Who Listens To Children.**

In the context of Child Protection Sunday we are provided with an opportunity to reflect on the words of Pope Francis who in a letter wrote on 2 February 2015 to the Presidents of the Episcopal Conferences and Superiors of Religious Institutes he stated that "Families need to know that the Church is making every effort to protect their children. They should also know that they have every right to turn to the Church with full confidence, for it is a safe and secure home."

What part do we play in this 'shared responsibility' of working to ensure that Church is a safe and secure community? In the Australia context through Child Protection Week and in particular this Sunday we are asked to be someone who listens to children, someone who will start a conversation with children and if needed, be that someone whom children will turn to when in need.
