#### **Divine Renovation**

This past week the group that has continued as an adult faith community in the Cathedral Parish following the Alpha program has reconvened to recommence its consideration of <u>Fr James Mallon's Divine Renovation</u> (bringing parishes to life from maintenance to mission). Fr James is Parish Priest of St Benedict's Parish Halifax, Canada.

The focus this week was on the five pillars of Parish Life

- 1. Worship
- 2. Ministry
- 3. Discipleship
- 4. Community
- 5. Evangelisation

Each of these five pillars of parish life can be aligned with Jesus' Great Commandment (You shall love the Lord your God with all of your heart, your soul and your mind and you shall love your neighbour as yourself) and the Great Commission (Go and make disciples, baptise and teach). These five key areas will be the focus for the next meeting of the Cathedral Parish Pastoral Council which will take place on Tuesday February 24<sup>th</sup> at 7.00 pm. Fr James reminded us that healthy parishes thrive when they focus outwards for mission which will then result in unity. Pope Francis, in his Apostolic Exhortation, Evangelii Gaudium (*The Joy of the Gospel*) has identified that the "parish is the presence of the Church in a given territory, an environment for hearing God's word,

for growth in the Christian life, for dialogue, proclamation, charitable outreach, worship and celebration.

In all its activities the parish encourages and trains its members to be evangelizers." (the group will gather 6.30 pm – 8.30 pm next Thursday). Parishioners interested in this discussion are welcome to join us in the Cathedral Presbytery.
