Child Safety Standards

The Parishes of St. Aloysius and St. James are committed to the well-being of its parishioners. As such we are embarking on a journey to develop and implement processes and protocols which aim to ensure all members of our parishes, but in particular children and vulnerable adults, participate in Parish life in a safe, caring and protective environment.

New state government legislation has come into effect with the New Year which sets standards for child safety. Safeguarding Officers have been appointed Bernadette Lynch (Redan Parish) and Pauline O'Brien (Sebastopol Parish) and both Parishes have a <u>Child Safety Policy</u> to ensure the safety and wellbeing of children in our care. A <u>Child Safety Code of Conduct</u> has been adopted for all who work with children at both Parishes.

These policies are consistent with Diocesan guidelines and protocols and adhere to the appropriate legislation at a State and Federal level. It will involve training and Codes of Conduct for all parishioners involved in planning and guiding church activities.
