Today Sunday, July 1st, is National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Sunday. This year's theme

is: "Because of Her, we can ..." The NATSICC Logo depicts a willy willy, the wind force in the centre a symbol of God's Spirit. The round concentric circles at the top symbolize God and Life, the

base depicts men and women receiving the Holy Spirit. The logo was designed by Mrs Olive Boddington, from Western Australia. The theme is part of a reflection for NATSIC Day: "For every day that I will rise, I will pray that the Lord will grace me with his presence to do God's Will, to set an example through my actions and words, in what I do and in all that I am, for my children and my people. And that, because of her, Mary our Mother, I know I can...." We pray in communion with Mary the Mother of God for all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, that they will be healed of all injustices and look forward to the future with hope in the Risen Lord.
