Families and supporters of those damaged as children have been vindicated as the truth has been revealed. Because a true faith disposition brings with it an openness to life's lessons and a sensitivity to learn from what is hardest to hear, we have said that the ribbons that have been replenished on the Cathedral Loudfence will remain and that later this year we will revisit this issue, seeking to engage with as many as possible in genuine, respectful dialogue.
