
Watoto Choir Visit

Amalgamated Parishes

Bishop Paul Bird announced a few weeks ago the formation of three new Parishes in our Diocese. St Mary MacKillop Parish, Western Border includes the former parishes of Casterton, Coleraine, Edenhope, Hamilton and Harrow. Father Patrick Mugavin is the Parish Priest and Father John Corrigan, Assistant Priest. Holy Family Parish, Northeast Mallee includes the former parishes of Swan Hill and Sea Lake with the northern part of the old Quambatook Parish. Father Matthew Thomas is the Parish Priest. Mary Glowrey Parish, East Wimmera covers the old parishes of Birchip, Charlton, Donald, St Arnaud and Wycheproof with the southern part of the former Quambatook Parish. Father Eugene McKinnon is the Parish Priest and Father Peter Jose is Assistant Priest. These developments offer a suggestion of things to come in our own district with Horsham-Nhill-Warracknabeal-Hopetoun, with consultation and information important aspects of any proposed reorganization.
