This month's edition highlights the talk that Father Peter Jose gave the Action for World Development group in Charlton recently at the East Charlton Hotel on the topic of India. He indicated that the picture often given by the Western media of India's deep poverty is not the picture all over of India. The country is growing not only in population but also in sharing wealth with many of those who in the past would have been poor. Father Peter assists Father Eugene McKinnon especially in the parishes of Sea Lake, Quambatook, Wycheproof and Ouyen.

Also in the edition is the story of Father Pat Flanagan's (or Flags as he refers to himself) newly published book which is called JUST WHAT IS SACRIFICE.

There is also a report on the Catholic Education Week activities in the diocese. Part of those activities include the celebration of Mass with St Joseph's St Mary's Donald and St Patrick's St Arnaud last week and other activities. There is a report about the work of the sisters of Mercy in Australia assisting in caring for over 140,000 people in the services they provide. They are now working to improve the environment what we leave with our children so that it will be better rather than worse than now.
