**PARISH COUNCIL NOTES:** last Wednesday, 9 November the Parish Council met these are some of the issues that were discussed.

- Funeral hospitality: discussions are to take place with the St Joseph's school auxiliary, finalising the process of looking after accounts and payments of bills into the future.
- The cost of hiring St Joseph's Hall for an outside organisation has been set at \$200. For others parishioners included it is to be set at \$100.
- Prices are to be finalised on split system air conditioners for the hall
- With the approval of St Joseph's school we shall celebrate 120 years of Catholic education in Charlton next year 2017. Dates are yet to be set.
- Youth activity: Friday, November 18 will be gathering of use at the croquet club for a fun evening 6 o'clock onwards. A pizza tea will be supplied.
- Columban calendars for 2017 have been ordered and will be available soon.

The next meeting will be on December 7<sup>th</sup> at 6 PM followed by a Christmas meal at the East Charlton hotel at 7 o'clock.
