#### Catholic Social Services: We must always say 'no' to violence in the home - Pope Francis

You would have seen the <u>2016</u> statement from the Bishops of Victoria

on domestic violence, acknowledging the importance of this issue, and urging the Catholic community to play a part in preventing and responding to violence within the family. It was distributed electronically, in December, and in the parish together with a supporting document designed to help all of us in responding when we are aware of abuse. As foreshadowed at that time, a more extensive resource kit has been prepared, and hard copies of this has been distributed to all parishes. This resource kit contains the following items: Introductory letter; Statement by Bishops of Victoria; 'Fast facts' about victims of violence; A guide for women experiencing violence; A guide for men experiencing violence; A guide for men seeking to change behaviour; A guide for family, friends, workmates; A Prayer to End Domestic and Family Violence; Services that can help – emergency referrals. And, for distribution and display are an Overview of Catholic response and A4 Poster. The kit, and individual items, are also available online, at www.css.org.au/dv. It is possible that your publicity about this kit, and your display of the poster, may prompt people within your parish who are experiencing violence to disclose their situation to you or others. The material in the kit is designed to assist you in supporting such people, including the provision of succinct information about family and domestic violence, together with phone numbers for referrals. The key messages in responding to victims are sensitivity and confidentiality. We do not advise you to counsel or attempt to mediate. An appropriate response is pastoral listening and referral to a professional service. 
