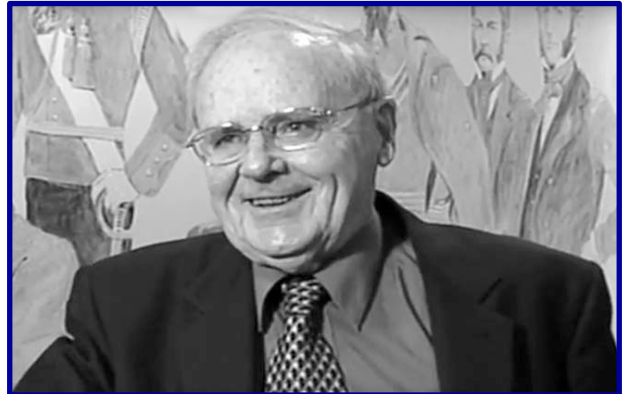




A DAY TO REMEMBER

A tribute to John Molony, a former priest of the Ballarat Diocese, is being planned for Saturday, October 19 at the Glowrey - MacKillop room in Ballarat (part of St Patrick's Cathedral Precinct).

John was a priest at the Cathedral Parish for around ten years and is remembered as a man dedicated to the church and his role as a priest. Circumstances at the time proved very difficult for him so he left. John later married Denise who remained his wife for the rest of what turned out to be an illustrious career as Professor of History at the Australian National University.



The occasion is titled "A tribute to John Molony and his concern for the issues of the day". It is dedicated to a man that was a prolific writer, having some twenty books and essays to his name as diverse as his work on topics related to church matters, the life and times of Ned Kelly and the Eureka Uprising.
