THE MARY MACKILLOP HOSPITALITY TRADES SKILLS CENTRE



St Mary MacKillop College, Swan Hill officially opened the Mary MacKillop Hospitality Trades Skills Centre on Wednesday, February 17. Mr Andrew Broad MP Federal Member for Mallee unveiled the plaque on behalf of the Federal Government, who contributed \$1,050,000 through the Trades Skills Centre grants program. Most Reverend Bishop Paul Bird blessed the buildings and those present.

The Trades Skills Centre includes the refurbishment and expansion of a domestic kitchen to include a commercial kitchen and teaching dining area and also the provision of equipment. It will deliver qualifications in hospitality to address skills shortages in the trade of cooking.

After the completion of the ceremony a delicious lunch was prepared and served by the St Mary MacKillop College Hospitality students.
