



## REMEMBERING OUR BRAVE MEN AND WOMEN OF ANZAC

On Tuesday, April 23, senior students from St Patrick's Primary School, Ballarat walked to the Old Ballarat Cemetery to take part in placing Australian Flags at the gravesites of soldiers who were involved in either World War 1 or World War 2.

Students were informed that only the soldiers who survived the war were actually buried in the cemetery but those who didn't survive are remembered on their family's gravestone.

Approximately one hundred and fifty flags were placed on graves at the Old Cemetery with approximately another 1500 being placed by more school children at the New Ballarat Cemetery. Lest We Forget.
