Local faith groups, community groups & individuals, in conjunction with local Aboriginal people, will hold a 'Blessing of the Rivers' ceremony at the junction of the rivers.

It's a simple, non-political gesture of good will that focuses communities' attention on the significance of water to life and a way that the Australian community can show symbolic support for our struggling communities.

This action has no political or formal organising body. It's simply a community action, in good faith.
