Cancellation of the 2020 Knights of the Southern Cross Archbishop's Dinner for the Priests Support and Education Fund

To our Patrons, Sponsors and Supporters,

On behalf of the Organising Committee of the Knights of the Southern Cross Archbishop's Dinner for the Priests Support and Education Fund, it is with sadness that I inform you of the unfortunate but necessary decision to cancel this year's KSC Archbishop's Dinner, due to the current social restrictions imposed on us by the State and Federal Governments due to the ongoing COVID-19 virus situation, and the uncertainty of what those conditions will be in August. It was originally planned for us to host the KSC Archbishop's Dinner on Friday August 21 at Moonee Valley Racecourse, with our guest speaker to be none other than the Archbishop of Melbourne, the Most Reverend Peter A. Comensoli. Unfortunately, this will now not go ahead.

When the current COVID-19 situation grew to significant concern, most organisations suspended their activities right away, even those months down the track. After consulting with Archbishop Comensoli, and with his encouragement, the Organising Committee continued to plan for the Dinner, in the hope that circumstances would improve in time for the hosting of the Dinner. We surmised that after these trying months, Catholics throughout Victoria would like something to look forward to, and with the Archbishop's Dinner being one of the pre-eminent social gatherings on the Victorian Catholic calendar, we had hoped that this would be so. I asked my Committee to continue planning, even though the likelihood of the Dinner not going ahead grew everyday. Their dedication to our cause was such that they continued to work with the same enthusiasm they had before this situation began, having worked since January to this effect. I am extremely proud of their efforts, even though the Dinner will now not go ahead.

I would like to thank the ongoing support of all the patrons, sponsors, and supporters who have made the previous 21 Archbishop's Dinners such wonderful events. While it is regrettable that we will not be able to meet in such circumstances this year, we look forward to seeing you again for next year's Archbishop's Dinner.
