Appointment New Master Catholic Theological College

Rev Dr Kevin Lenehan has today been announced as the new Master of Catholic Theological College, replacing Father Shane Mackinlay who has recently been appointed as Bishop of Sandhurst.

President of the College, Archbishop Peter Comensoli said a formal process set out in CTC's Constitution had been conducted and announced that Father Lenehan had been elected and appointed as Master of Catholic Theological College for a term from 16 September 2019 to 31 December 2022.

The Archbishop expressed on behalf of the CTC Senate its gratitude for Father Lenehan's readiness to undertake this responsibility and formally expressed the Senate's appreciation of the generosity shown by the Diocese of Ballarat in making him available for this position.
