The Sacraments are ordered sequentially:

BAPTISM, **CONFIRMATION**, **RECONCILIATION** (part 1), **EUCCHARIST**, **RECONCILIATION** (part 2)

The next step in your
Sacramental journey is...

CONFIRMATION

For Baptised Catholics in
primary school level Yr 3 or
older.

Followed by...

RCIC

(Rite of Christian Initiation of Children)

For children of Catholics who have reached primary school
age and haven't been Baptised Catholic OR for children
who have been baptised in another Christian tradition and
want to be received into the Catholic Church.

RECONCILIATION – PART 1 (JUNIOR)

For Baptised Catholics in primary school level of Year 4 or older who
have ALREADY celebrated Confirmation.

(A requirement BEFORE preparing for and celebrating EUCCHARIST)

RECONCILIATION – PART 2 (SENIOR)

In primary school year level 5 or 6. Confirmation,
junior reconciliation (part 1) and Eucharist have been
celebrated.

The second experience before the end of primary
school.

EUCCHARIST –

For Baptised Catholics in primary school level of Year 4
or older who have celebrated RECONCILIATION.
