

WORLD DAY OF PRAYER

On Friday, March 1, Our Lady Help of Christians School Murtoa participated in the World Day of Prayer service. This service was held in the Multipurpose Room at school.

The World Day of Prayer is a global ecumenical movement led by Christian women who welcome you to join in prayer and action for peace and justice.
