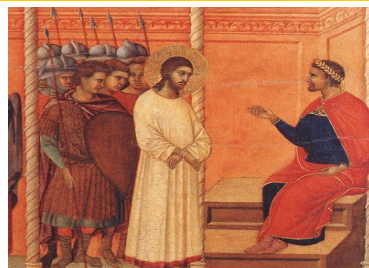

they are burnt during Communion.
We also bring our gifts for children to the

PRAYERS NOT BEFORE MASS. After Mass
Vinnies collect and sort them, ready for dis-
tributing.
