JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY

In keeping with the main purpose Pope Francis sees to be his God-given Mission as Pope, of creating a Church that shows love to the outcasts, Pope Francis will open the Jubilee or Holy Door in St Peter's Church this Tuesday, December 8. This date is chosen because it is fifty years exactly since the closing of the Second Vatican Council. Actually Pope Francis has already inaugurated the Jubilee year for the Continent of Africa, when, a week ago, he opened the doors of the Cathedral of Bangui, the Capital of the most war-torn of all of the countries of Africa, the Central African Republic. For those interested, last Tuesday, November 30, marked 800 years since the closing of another General Council of the Church, the Fourth Lateran Council. One of the Decrees of that Council was that the Roman Curia was to be reformed.
