Food for Thought: Because this story is so graphic and moving, we can miss the import of the last paragraph of this reading. We know that Peter and others had left their fishing cooperative to follow Jesus who was obviously not now engaged in the carpentry trade. How were they to survive on the mission?



His band of followers included rather well-to-do women with funds and contacts which enabled the mission to continue. Without their financial aid, Jesus could not have conducted his mission in the way he wanted to. The gospel record is clear and the church needs to take it to heart. Jesus accepted women to an outrageous degree, overturning all the norms of society. Jesus depended on women, to carry out his mission as an itinerant preacher of no fixed address. Jesus not merely preached the reign of God. He imaged it in his band of travelling companions, both female and male. He was, He is the Saviour of all human beings without distinction based on race, ethnicity or gender. He is truly the Saviour of all humanity. He is the Saviour of the world.

Why do we make the sign of the cross? - Do you rush through the sign of the cross as if swatting a fly? Don't! This gesture contains powerful symbolism connected with the Trinity and with your baptism. Indeed, it can be viewed as a prayer in itself. By making this sign you are declaring: I am completely under the power of the risen Christ, our Redeemer. You are identifying yourself with generations of Christians, for the common usage of the familiar formula - In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen - can be traced back to the second century.
