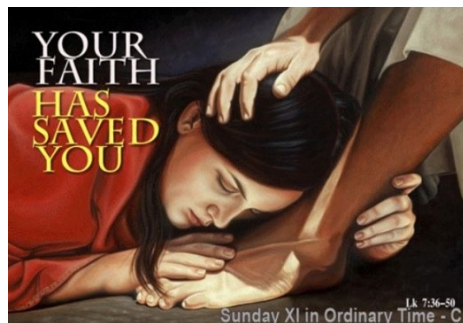

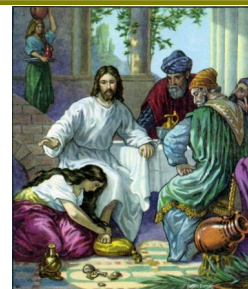
There is a form for you to sign on the marble slab in the foyer if you want a copy. They will become available at the Piety Stall in due course. Any profits will go to Vinnies.
