Window Replacement at St. Joseph's

Timboon: As many of you had noticed and commented upon the untidy state of the film covering on the lower windows, the finance committee, in consultation with the leadership team and approval from Fr Laurie O'Toole, our administrator, made the decision to replace the lower windows with toughened glass. It seemed that the most prudent action in order to maintain acceptable standards and to meet current building guidelines in the most cost effective way was to replace the windows. Water Pipe Replacement at St. Joseph's

Timboon: It came to the attention of Leadership team that when it rained water poured down under the church building. This has been happening for some time and could potentially effect the integrity of the church structure. After Gerard Vogels did lots of digging and after consultation with two plumbers, it was found that the water from the hall just went into old earthen pipes that stopped at back of church, hence after a heavy rain water drained under the church, onto the concrete area and down into the front garden bed. The solution was to put a new pipe along the presbytery into an existing pit and then the water will drain into the town storm water system. A sincere thanks to Gerard for all his time and physical labour to make this happen for the minimum cost to our parish.
