Focus on the Scripture



On first reading of this text, many of us would feel sympathy with Martha who is left to do all the work. But a more careful reading of the text

uncovers the real problem. Martha is ready 'to welcome Jesus into her house'. And yet she becomes so preoccupied with the fuss of getting food ready that she is failing to do exactly what she set out to do: offer welcome to

the person of Jesus. Mary, on the other hand, is attentive to the words and teachings of Jesus. Who has offered the true welcome? The response of these two women are not in opposition, but rather

indicate two ways of acting which should be come integrated in how we relate to others: attentive friendship and generous and practical service. The gospel of the Good Samaritan from last week shows us a model of selfless service. Here we are presented with the other side of the story: the need to also be attentive and listen to the word of God so that we don't get caught up in that which is ultimately unimportant.

With which of these women in this story do you more readily identify? How might you cultivate the other side of yourself?
