FRANCIS OF ASSISI. Saint Francis was born at Assisi in 1182. After a carefree youth, he renounced his paternal wealth and committed himself to God. He led a life of evangelical poverty and preached the love of God to all. He established a rule which a number of his companions followed and which gained the approval of the Holy See. Later, he founded an order of nuns and a society of lay persons who practice penance while living in the world. He died in 1226.
