A challenge from Laudato Si: On care for our common home (Pope Francis, reminds us that each one of us has a distinctive gift to offer our world and we each have a part to play. "All of us can co-operate as instruments of God for the care of creation, each according to his or her own culture, experience, involvements and talents" (LS 14). To achieve this belief, we must first recognize that there is a deep interconnection between all created things. ACTION: Use less paper and plastic products – use a re-usable water bottle, use cloth bags for shopping.
