Dennington Day Out



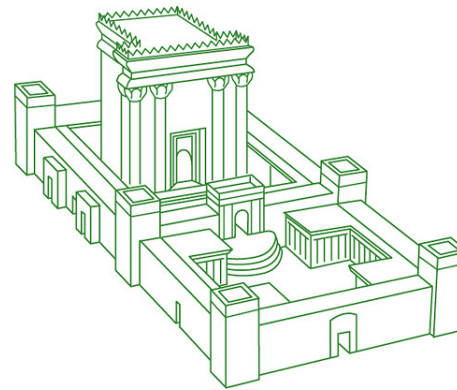
