ADVENT & CHRISTMAS TIME

Because Christmas Day this year is on a Sunday, Advent will run its full four weeks. Christmas Time however will be very short, two weeks + one day, and it actually finishes on a Monday. I will try to explain this. Christmas ends with Jesus' receiving the Holy Spirit at his Baptism in the River Jordan. This feast is on the Sunday after Epiphany (the coming of the Magi to Jesus.) The proper date for Epiphany is January 6. However, in countries like Australia, where the Epiphany is not a Holy Day of Obligation, the Epiphany is celebrated on the Sunday after New Year. Because New Year 2017 is a Sunday, here we will celebrate Epiphany on Sunday, January 8, when those countries that keep the regular calendar will be celebrating the Baptism of Our Lord. So, in Australia, when this occurs, we celebrate the Baptism of Our Lord on the Monday straight after Epiphany, ie. Monday, January 9. As there won't be enough turn up here on Monday, January 9, we will have to put away the Christmas Trees, Cribs, Christmas Wreaths etc. etc. in St Joseph's Church straight after Mass on Sunday, January 8.

To save repeating this notice at this time next year, I will point out now that the same anomaly will occur in 2018. It occurs whenever New Year is on a Sunday or a Monday.
