### Pope Francis' Message for 50<sup>th</sup> World Day of Peace (1<sup>st</sup> January)

'Non-Violence: A Style of Politics for Peace' ([www.vatican.va](http://www.vatican.va))

- Violence is not the cure for our broken world
- Jesus also lived in violent times and proclaimed his Good News of love
- Nonviolence is not passive surrender; it is a commitment to justice that is more powerful than violence
- Violence arises from the human heart; therefore, before all else, nonviolence must be practised within families. It is equally urgent to make progress on disarmament and to end domestic violence and the abuse of women and children.
- The beatitudes (Mt 5:3-10) offer a portrait of a blessed, good and authentic person. We are all challenged to apply them in whatever situation we face: to be peacemakers and to show mercy.
- "All of us want peace. Many people build it day by day through small gestures and acts; many of them are suffering, yet patiently persevere in their efforts to be peacemakers. In 2017, may we dedicate ourselves prayerfully and actively to banishing violence from our hearts, words and deeds, and to becoming nonviolent people and to building nonviolent communities that care for our common home."
