Note:-

2016's negative balance is a result mainly of the expenditure of \$14,316.94 for repairs to the church roof plus the cost of \$6,245.45 for the replacement of the old heater in the church foyer with a new reverse cycle air conditioner. Other expenses included the provision of a new hot water service for the presbytery (\$1,430) and the replacement of the 45-year-old presbytery central heating system. (\$5,577.17).
