FR. FRANK MADDEN RIP: We pray for retired Ballarat diocese priest, Fr James Francis “Frank” Madden, who died aged 90 on 20th April. A “late vocation” when ordained in St Patrick’s Cathedral, Ballarat on 27th July 1963 and who faithfully served our diocese since then, his appointments included Vicar General of our diocese, Administrator of St Patrick’s Cathedral parish and Parish Priest of Redan, Horsham and Peshurst. His Funeral Mass was last Thursday at his home town Koroit followed by his burial at Tower Hill cemetery.
