Did You Know..?

It is planned to hold a Synod of the whole of the Catholic Church in Australia in 2020. (You may not remember the last time this happened - it took place in 1937!) The intention is that the Synod will plan for the future of the Catholic Church in Australia, taking note of all the complexities of our age. An Executive Committee of 14 members has recently been chosen to prepare for the Synod. Only one is from Victoria: Dr Gemma Cruz, senior lecturer in theology at the Australian Catholic University. We can expect to hear more about the Synod in the coming months and as we more closely approach the year 2020.

Odd Spot
