The application form relating to the proposed sale of the St Patrick's Gordon Presbytery has been completed and signed by Fr Gary. The form has been submitted for consideration by the Committee of Diocesan Consulters including Bishop Paul Bird, and the Diocesan Finance Council. It will be some weeks before a decision is received from the Diocesan Office. The next stage is to work on the process of aligning property titles between the church and presbytery, and making any changes necessary to separate the utilities and services to the two properties.
